CHALLENGER BASEBALL

Syracuse Challenger Baseball (SCB) was founded in 1982 with a mission to provide life-changing experiences through baseball for individuals with special needs. In 2003, Executive Director Dom Cambareri took the helm, leading SCB's expansion to make the league available to new players across the CNY Community. From 2010 to 2024, SCB has grown into the largest Little League Challenger Division in the world, and features nearly 250 players participating in Junior, Senior, and Adult Divisions.

In 2006, despite challenges presented by the lack accessible fields in the community, SCB nearly tripled in size under Cambareri's guidance. After the new skilled player Senior Division was added in 2007, Cambareri and league volunteers realized that SCB must embark on a bold new mission – to build a fully accessible multi-field complex that SCB players and all CNY athletes could call home – the Challenger Field of Dreams.

CARRIER PARK "FIELD OF DREAMS" SUPERFIELD EXPANSION

In 2015, Little League's new Challenger Division rules helped Syracuse Challenger Baseball's (SCB) establish the new Adult Division, featuring players aged 21 and above. SCB's unwavering commitment to the inclusion of players of all ages and with all differing abilities ensured that every special Challenger player would thrive on the baseball diamond for years to come.

In 2016, SCB realized its ten-year dream as the inspirational driving force behind the opening of the Challenger Field of Dreams at Carrier Park. This trailblazing facility featured state-of-the art baseball diamonds, provided SCB with its own home fields, and empowered the players to experience the pure joy of playing that National Pastime side by side with their peers. 
2 ADA Championship level Baseball/Softball Diamonds



4 ADA ·Full Size Basketball Courts with Adjustable Nets and Special Navigable Playing Surface


